NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that on Tuesday, the 3rd day of November, 2020, a General Election will be conducted entirely by mail in all of Clallam County. The purpose of this election is to approve or reject State Measures, Advisory Votes, County Charter Amendments, Local Propositions, and to elect officials to County, State and Federal positions. Ballots for this election will be mailed to all qualified voters on October 14, 2020.

VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINES: Pursuant to RCW 29A.08.140, the registration deadlines for all precincts within the districts voting in the General Election will be as follows:

Online or by mail: Last day to register or update registration is October 26, 2020 (Registrations must be received by the Auditor's Office by this date). Printable voter registration forms can be found online at www.clallam.net/elections. You can also register using the online portal at www.votewa.gov.

In-person: Last day to register or update registration at the Clallam County Auditor's Office is November 3, 2020. You may register to vote or update your registration at the Auditor's Office, 223 E 4th St, Suite 1 in Port Angeles between 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. On Election Day, November 3, we are open until 8:00 p.m.

A registered voter who fails to transfer his or her residential address by this deadline may vote according to his/her previous registration address.

VOTING AID: To assist elderly and disabled persons in voting their ballot, an Accessible Voting Unit is available in the Auditor's Office beginning October 14, 2020 through 8:00 p.m. on Election Day.

OPEN PUBLIC MEETING NOTICE: The Canvassing Board of Clallam County, pursuant to chapter 29A.60 RCW, will hold public meetings on the following dates and times:

- Canvassing Board Meeting – November 23, 2020 at 1:00 p.m.
- Canvassing Board Meeting – Certification of Election – November 24, 2020 at 2:00 p.m.

All meetings will be held in the Election Center located in the basement of the Clallam County Courthouse, 223 E 4th St, Room 072, Port Angeles, WA.
