Worksite:	Salt Creek or Dungeness Recreation Areas
Position Goal:	To provide a positive, helpful, and informative presence in campgrounds and recreation areas and provide additional on-site security.
Sample Activities:	<p>Provide campground and recreational area information and rules to campers and visitors. Answer visitors' questions and provide information about local services and attractions. Help campers and visitors contact emergency assistance as needed.</p> <p>Patrol campground and recreational areas on a regular basis to assess and report on the status of public lands. Open and close recreational site gates as scheduled.</p> <p>Regularly inspect park or fair restrooms, picnic shelters, campsites, campfire pits and boat launch areas to ensure they are safe and clean for public use. Immediately secure vandalized or unsafe facilities until they are repaired.</p> <p>Report vandalism, illegal or abusive behavior immediately to park staff and/or the local law enforcement agency.</p> <p>Perform maintenance tasks with the approval and under the direction of the on site Park manager.</p>
Timeframe:	Length of commitment: Minimum of one month Schedule: Arranged by park staff
Minimum Qualifications:	Ability to perform duties in a friendly and professional manner. Communications skills to deal effectively in confrontational situations. Ability to provide a clean, attractive motor home, camper or travel trailer. Willingness to work cooperatively and under direction of Parks staff Valid State Drivers License and proof of insurance on private vehicle(s)
Desired Qualifications:	skilled in oral communications and/or handy person skills
